

Intradistrict sibling rule

The "sibling rule" which was part of past intradistrict enrollment practice, is no longer in effect.

Intradistrict open enrollment transfers depend entirely upon the capacity available in each building. Building capacities for each grade level at all district schools will be determined by the administration as required by Ohio Revised Code.

Students wishing to enroll and attend school in a building other than the one they are assigned to in 2005-06, should have intradistrict enrollment applications completed and returned to Central Office by 5 p.m. on Feb. 28.

Intradistrict enrollment applications for students in grades K-11 may be obtained at Central Office, 7030 Coffman Road, or any Dublin school building.

Applications are also available from the district's web site: www.dublinschools.net. Click on "forms" once you reach the district site to download the application.

The exceptions to the sibling rule are listed below and are special circumstances dating back several years.

- * Any current 8th grade students who reside in the Southeast Quadrant who will have an older sibling attending Scioto will be approved to attend Scioto if they submit a request in writing to the Superintendent by Feb. 28.

- * Any current 8th grade students who reside in the Choice area who will have an older sibling attending Scioto will be approved to attend Scioto if they submit a request in writing to the Superintendent by Feb. 28

- * Starting with our current 7th grade class, all students in the Southeast Quadrant and Choice areas will attend their assigned high school according to the high school boundaries approved by the Dublin Board of Education.
